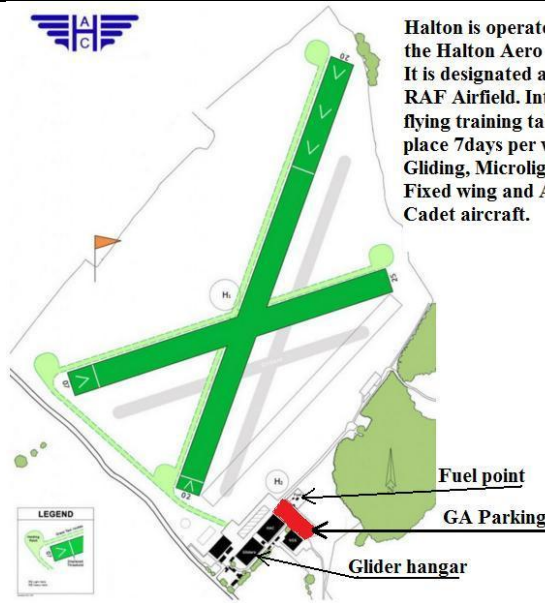
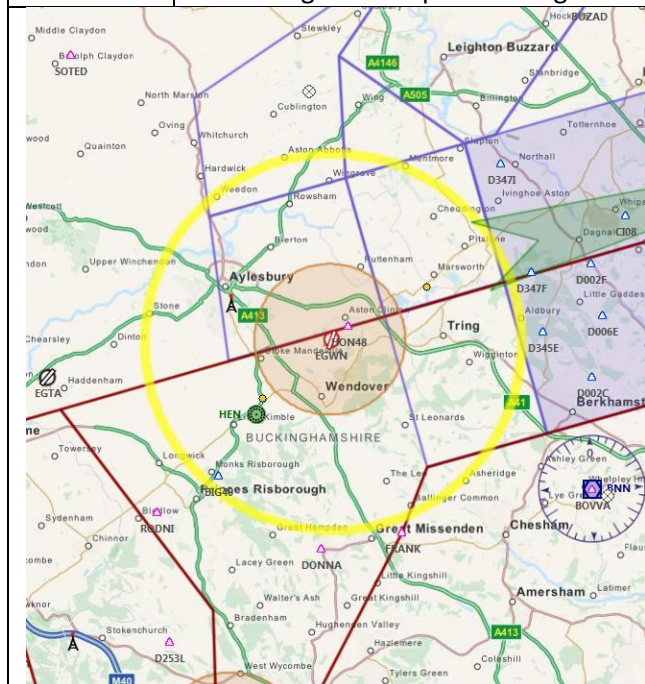

HELICOPTER OPERATIONS	If Gliding is taking place, <b>REMAIN CLEAR OF GLIDER CIRCUIT/OUTSIDE ATZ.</b> Use 'Non active' threshold, <b>UNDER FIXED WING CIRCUIT</b> , for arrival / departure, NOT ABOVE 700ft QFE. (If under F/Wing circuit, Helipad 2 may be used). <b>DO NOT CROSS THE CENTRELINE of the RUNWAY IN USE INSIDE THE ATZ.</b>			
SPECIAL RULES	<b>NO DEAD SIDE JOINS or FLIGHT, NO OVERHEAD JOINS</b> due to INTENSE Glider activity. Report AT <b>MINIMUM 5nm</b> . Be prepared to route via VRPs:- <b>TERRICK</b> , 2.5nm SW of A/D for Runways 02 and 07. N051.45.59.630 W000.47.10.350. <b>LAKES</b> , 2.5nm NE of A/D for Runways 20 and 25. N051.48.56.990 W000.40.07.650. <b>CROSS VRPs AT 1500ft QFE inbound.</b> <b>ALL DEPARTURES CLIMB STRAIGHT AHEAD</b> to 1500ft QFE (1550ft QNH), BEFORE turning on route. <b>UNLESS GOING TO ANOTHER CONTROLLER</b> , remain on frequency until 5dme.
