

GLOUCESTER – MARHAM NAVIGATION

The direct route is Gloucester, DTY VOR (116.4) and then direct Marham.

As there is little in the way of good waypoints in N Cambs and Norfolk I will try to cruise at 5000 , this will be at least 500' below the lowest controlled airspace on the way.

FS9 reckons that the track EGBJ to DTY is 071 degrees and 43 miles and from DTY to EGYM is 071 deg and 66 miles.

Things to look out for to ensure you are still on track

Banbury 3 miles S at 30 miles from EGBJ

Direct over Northampton 10 miles from DTY

Sywell Aifrield 2 miles left at 15 miles DTY

Peterborough Airfield t 3 miles Left at 37 miles

Downham Market/Junction of the Ouse and the 2 fen drains at 60 miles on track.

If one gets lost (geographically challenged (-:) Kings Lynn on the SE corner of the Wash is a really obvious feature that will be easy to find and then 10 miles on 145 should find Marham
